The Laurel Springs Board of Education has developed a policy for students with asthma or allergies requiring administration of a pre-filled auto-injector mechanism containing epinephrine ('Epi-Pen'), to be provided by the parent, as ordered in writing by your child's physician. This order is effective only for the current school year and must be renewed each year.

The Epi-Pen is to be administered by the School Nurse or designee, who has been trained by the School Nurse. The School Nurse, in collaboration with you and your child's physician, will develop an individualized healthcare plan and an individualized emergency plan, which will be signed by you and your child's physician.

This serves as a statement notifying you that if procedures specified in the policy are followed, the district shall have no liability as the result of any injury arising from the administration of a pre-filled auto-injector mechanism containing epinephrine to the pupil and that the parents or guardians shall indemnify and hold harmless the district and its employees or agents against any claims arising out of the administration of a pre-filled auto-injector mechanism containing epinephrine to the pupil.

Further, this statement serves as notification that if procedures specified in JNSA 18A:40-12.5 are followed, the district shall have no liability as a result of any injury arising from the administration of a pre-filled auto-injector mechanism containing epinephrine to the pupil.
