Physical Exams and Scoliosis

The school nurse will:

- check and record students' height, weight, vision, hearing, and blood pressure as per policy.
- check students for scoliosis beginning at age 10 and then biennially, in grades 6 and 8.
- notify the parent/guardian by phone or written notice if a problem is found.

If you do not want these screenings completed, please send in a note at the beginning of the school year. Have them completed by your own healthcare provider and send in the results so that I can keep your child's medical record current.

NEW STUDENTS

A current physical exam (within the last 365 days) given by your child's physician is to be completed prior to entering pre-K or Kindergarten (kindergarten students new to LS School). This should include both vision and hearing testing.

For all transfer students, a recent physical exam or previous school entry medical exam may be used for the medical exam requirement.
