

# REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STUDENTS

## 1. Child needs a physical

## 2. Child needs proof of immunizations

All students, prior to entering school must have the following immunizations:

<b>DPT/DtaP</b>	Four doses, the last dose being administered on or after your child's fourth birthday, OR any five doses. Age seven or older, three doses.
<b>Polio</b>	Three doses, the last dose being administered on or after your child's fourth birthday, OR any four doses. Age seven or older, three doses.
<b>MMR</b>	One dose of MMR (Measles/Mumps/Rubella) on or after your child's first birthday.
<b>Measles</b>	A second dose of a Measles-containing vaccine (example; MMR, MR, or Measles only) with a time span of at least one month from the date of the first MMR, OR documentation of Measles immunity.
<b>Hepatitis B</b>	If your child has not already completed the Hepatitis B series, the series of three injections must be started prior to entering school and completed during the school year.
<b>Varicella</b>	All students born after January 1998 will be required to have the Varicella Vaccine, administered on or after your child's first birthday, or proof of the disease Chickenpox.
<b>Physical Exam</b>	A current physical exam (within the last 365 days) given by your child's physician is to be completed prior to entering school. This should include both vision and hearing testing.

**All in state transfers must provide proof of immunization at registration.**

**All out of state and out of country transfers will have a 30 day provisional status to obtain proof of immunization if they don't already have them. Proof of your child's immunizations and physical must be recorded on the papers given to you at registration and stamped and signed by your child's physician. Failure to comply may result in your child's exclusion from school.**

***Please be advised that immunizations and a physical are two separate requirements.***
