Secretary's Report

Included in this month's agenda are the financial reports for July. The fiscal year has been rolled over and the prior year purchase orders have begun to be paid. The state aid payment normally scheduled for September 22, 2020 has been postponed until October 8, 2020. Presently, there are no cash flow issues, even with the state aid payment postponement. Mr. Thompson and Mr. Attanasi prepared the budget for the 20-21 fiscal year that in the event, the state aid payment was withheld the district would remain solvent.

# Superintendent's Report

The start of school has been a smooth process for educators and administrators. Mr. Attanasi has received various emails from parents expressing their pleasure in their experience with the start of school. He also explained that students who are currently fully remote can move to hybrid learning in the second semester. Mr. Mahlman and Mr. Attanasi have discussed this matter and have received parent requests to move their student from a fully remote to a hybrid model as soon as possible. Mr. Attanasi's hope is to move the students to a longer school day if the virus remains manageable.

Mr. Brown asked where does the district stand with the on premises dumpster. Mr. Attanasi explained that the dumpster was placed on hold during the pandemic. However, he will be looking into dumpster options as we get closer to preparing the 21-22 budget.

Mr. Minder suggested an environment service club as a great outdoor team activity which would benefit the Boro in Spring 2021. This club could focus on enhancing and cleaning up local township parks, which haven't been the forefront of the township's focus due to the pandemic.
