When Illness Occurs at School



When a child becomes ill in school, the nurse may determine that he or she should be sent home. Parents should make arrangements for the child to be picked up at school as soon as possible after the nurse's phone call.

If your phone number or emergency contacts change throughout the school year, please let me know so I can update the records.

Remember, school policy states that a student must be emesis (vomiting), diarrhea, and/or fever free for at least 24 hours before returning to school.
